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

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

## Earn Continuing Education Credit for Attending this Doble Conference!

### What are Continuing Education Credits (CEUs)?

Doble Engineering is an Authorized Provider of Continuing Education Credits (CEUs) through the International Association of Continuing Education and Training (IACET). Continuing Education Credits provide a permanent record of the educational accomplishments of an individual who has completed one or more significant educational experiences. Awarding the CEUs approved by IACET also provides a quality indicator for Doble's continuing education and training programs because it means Doble has been reviewed and approved for complying with internationally recognized standards. One Continuing Education Unit (CEU) is defined as ten content hours of participation in an organized continuing education experience under responsible sponsorship, capable direction, and qualified instruction. CEUs are issued at all Doble Seminars and Conferences that meet the IACET standards.

#### Tutorial: Transformer Internal Inspections Guidelines

Transformer internal inspections have historically helped to determine the acceptability of a transformer upon receipt. The technique can also be used to confirm and sometimes allows a problem within the transformer to be fixed in the substation. The internal inspection has many times been helpful to save time, expense and shorten outage times.

David Deines of Progress Energy Florida, Harry Ruggles of American Electric Power, Greg Bennett of Excel Energy and Phil Prout of National Grid have volunteered their expertise to help others perform internal inspections.
