You should also have:

- Successfully completed university degree, for example but not limited to: Safety Engineer (Bsc/MSc), Mechanical /Electrical /Chemical Engineer (Bsc/MSc)

- Solid knowledge of machine directives (and upcoming regulations) and use of work equipment directives and their practical implementation
- HSE Management systems knowledge: ISO 45001, 14001, 50001
- Knowledge and experience in managing occupational risks and related EU and national legislation

This role requires availability for business travel around 40-50% to our manufacturing locations, mainly in Europe, so preferably, you live close to an airport in Northern Europe.
